

Preliminary Scholarship Application 2026

The LEO Only scholarship is open to high school seniors or students already enrolled in an accredited college program. The parent is an active or retired sworn law enforcement officer or fallen sworn law enforcement officer. Any student within the jurisdiction of LEO-ONLY, may file an application.

The Preliminary Application must be filed with the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee, no later than **February 15, 2026**.

NO EXCEPTIONS OR EXTENSIONS WILL BE PREMITTED WITHOUT LEO- ONLY BOARD APPROVAL.

Only one application may be filed per student. We require a Social Security number for our records. If you do not have one, you should apply at your nearest Social Security Office. There is no charge to obtain this number.

Financial need, leadership, academics, as well as citizenship, personality, perseverance and resourcefulness are the criteria by which applicants will be judged. Students of outstanding merit have the best chance to win our award. Experience indicates students with high scholarship ratings, excellent leadership qualities and a well-rounded personality generally qualify in the group given final consideration.
